What is Coaches Corner?

What do I need to do?

Record a video on your phone. No editing, graphics, music, or production is necessary, we'll take care of all of that. Videos can be filmed at practice, in a batting cage, on the field, or anywhere you're comfortable.

What happens after I upload?

1. Upload your raw video.
2. We'll edit it for social media.
3. We'll send you the finished version for approval.
4. After approval, we'll publish it and tag/collaborate with your program whenever possible.
5. You'll receive the finished video to post, share, or use however you'd like.

KEEP IT NATURAL

Please don't mention 1733 Baseball in your video. This is **not** an advertisement or promotional video for 1733 Baseball. The focus should be entirely on **your coaching, your baseball program, and the instruction you're sharing**. If you're answering a mindset or leadership question, a simple introduction is perfect:

"Hey everyone, I'm Coach [Name] with [Program] Baseball..."

Then jump right into your message.

If you're demonstrating a drill, there's no need to introduce yourself or speak directly to the camera. Simply coach the drill exactly as you normally would with your players. We'll handle the editing, captions, and formatting while keeping your instruction and message authentic.

How long should the video be?

60–90 seconds is ideal. That's what the final video will typically look like on social media. However, don't feel like you have to fit everything into that timeframe.

If you're demonstrating a drill, such as an infield progression, hitting drill, or practice segment, and the full explanation takes 3–5 minutes, that's perfectly fine. Record it naturally, and we'll edit it into one or more shorter, social media-ready clips while keeping the instruction and teaching points intact.

Submission Requirements

Video Tips:

- ✓ Film Vertically when possible
- ✓ Record in daylight when possible
- ✓ Keep background noise to a minimum
- ✓ Speak clearly
- ✓ Don't worry about mistakes, we can edit them out
